Conditions of Entry:	Entry is based on acceptance of NDHD's Club Rules & Regulations. The onus is on the competitor to be aware of the rules that apply to the BEC grounds & NDHD events.			
Horse Health Declarations:	A completed Horse Health Declaration will be required to be handed over at gear check ON THE DAY OF THE COMPETITION. NO Health Declaration, NO Ride!

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- <u>NO</u> refunds after closing date unless a veterinary/doctors certificate supplied. Please refer to the Refund policy on our website for instruction.
- EA rules will be adhered to unless otherwise stated. All competitors please note that swabbing may occur at any events conducted by this Club. Horses restricted to three (3) tests at two (2) consecutive levels. Competitors must wear boots, gloves & safety approved helmet.
- Maximum of 30 horses per class (reserve list may be created).
- If the day is cancelled, the Organising Committee will retain 20% of the nomination fee for processing.
- Competitors must report to the Gear Steward 10 minutes prior to your allocated time. If riders are happy to ride earlier than their allocated time slot, you are welcome to confer with the Gear Steward on this for your class.
- Riding is to be done in an orderly manner so as not to interfere with other competitors.
- Any disputes are to be directed to the Ground Jury ONLY.
- Please ensure that you leave the grounds clean & tidy. Any yards used MUST have manure/feed etc removed prior to your leaving the grounds.
- All members who are competing can expect to be rostered for pencilling or gear checking. Jobs will be allocated & you will be advised on the draw.
- Competitors unable to stay for the presentation must supply \$3 & a stamped self-addressed envelope to have tests & ribbons posted to them, if so requested.
- Members are limited to riding a maximum of two (2) horses per competition.

Class 20: - Green or New Horse Class – this is for those members who have a new horse, or a young, green horse that they would like to give them some exposure. Times will be allocated at the finish of an Arena for those wishing to ride in the arena for exposure. EA Rules still apply.

If your horse is behaving dangerously, or there is concern for other riders/horses/people on the ground, due to the behaviour of your horse, you can be asked to take the horse home. You are still required to pay for 1 class & the \$2 ground fee per horse, extra for yards or stables.

Northern Districts Hack & Dressage Club is a COVID Safe Site. Contact details are required for tracing purposes upon entry.

This is a pre-nominated event. Riders must be a financial member of NDHD.

If you are unwell the morning of the event, please do not come as we have COVID-19 policies we are required to follow. We must record names & details of everyone who attends on the day. Make sure you Check in to the Mobile Nominate log in that will be available on the grounds for ALL of your family. Spectators must adhere to social distancing rules of 1.5m & must not congregate in areas. Please park with social distancing in mind. Sanitiser stations will be on the grounds, please use them & wash your hands regularly.

BIOSECURITY – All Horse owners & competitors should be aware that you a biosecurity obligation to take all reasonable steps to ensure your activities do not spread a pest, disease or contaminant. Competitors are asked to ensure good biosecurity practices at home & at the event & to follow the instructions of the Organising Committee & the Biosecurity Manager or risk expulsion from the event. All horses entering the grounds must be in good health, with no signs of illness. Horse Health Declarations (HHD) are a mandatory requirement for all events. Do not share equipment, including food and water containers between horses. Competitors are responsible for cleaning up manure from yards & the grounds & placing it in the designated areas. Please use your own shovel/rake. Competitors are required to advise the event organisers immediately if a horse is sick. Everyone handling the horse should wash or sanitise hands & stop all non essential contact.
