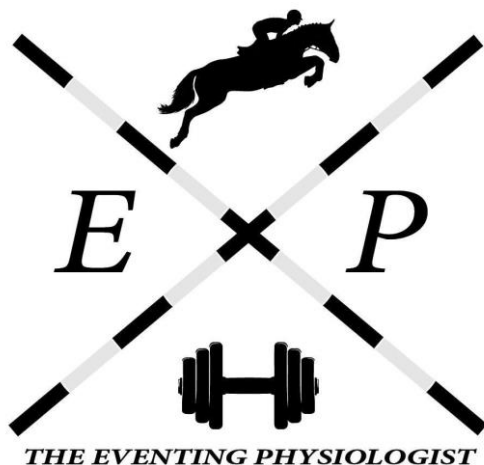

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- EA rules will be adhered to unless otherwise stated. Horses restricted to three (3) tests at two (2) consecutive levels. Competitors must wear boots, gloves & safety approved helmet.
- Maximum of 30 horses per class. Classes will be split if required.
- If the day is cancelled, the Organising Committee will retain 20% of the nomination fee for processing.

## Rules and FAQ

Due to the current changing situation with COVID-19, Northern Districts Hack and Dressage strongly advises riders to follow all government directives when participating in this online competition.

Upon entering a class with Northern Districts Hack and Dressage, you accept and abide by the following rules/conditions:

- Ride at your own risk, NDHD take no responsibility for any injuries occurred to horse or rider when filming a test.
- Videos of tests must not be entered if they have already been judged in another competition.
- Judges decision is final.

### Arena Sizing + Boundary

- Arena can be 20x40m or 20x60m – Use your own digression. Some tests cannot be ridden in a 40x20.
- Letter markers must be clearly visible from C throughout the video.
- Arena boundary must be indicated by cones/poles.
- Compulsory markers must be placed in each corner and at each letter.
- The arena and the boundary markers must be safe.

### Filming Guidelines

- The person filming must stand behind C and is to stay in the same position throughout the recording, zooming in slightly when the rider is at the A end of the arena. When zooming, both long sides of the arena must still be in the frame to allow judging of accuracy.
- The person videoing must stand back far enough from C that the whole horse and rider is in frame when riding past C.
- Video must be filmed in full and not edited in any way eg. No cuts or text overlay
- Video to start 5 seconds before entering at A and to finish after rider has moved from the final halt
- Must have sound – Callers allowed but movements to be called twice each only. No other training advice allowed – penalty elimination.
- Video to be uploaded to youtube – can be unlisted
- If filming on a mobile, the mobile must be turned landscape before and throughout filming.

### How many tests can I ride?

- Riders can enter a maximum of three tests per horse over two consecutive levels.
- Riders can enter as many horses as they wish.

### What do I wear?

- All gear must be to EA standards – Please check rule book if unsure
- Any colour saddle pad is permitted.
- Neat and tidy riding attire. Relaxation on colour.
- Gloves MUST be worn
- Must wear approved boots and helmet

- Spurs and whips are allowed as per EA rules.
- Plaiting welcomed but not essential. Horse to be neat and tidy.

Tests may be ridden in a 20x40 if appropriate. Otherwise 60x20 preferred.
